



Below is a list of plants that may be in flower in time for the Show – to give ideas for what to plant in your garden to enter Class 10 –“ A vase of 3 or more varieties of bee friendly flowers”.

There may of course be others not listed, but as a general guide, bees favour blue/purple coloured flowers, and trumpet or single flowers where it is easier for them to get to the nectar, as opposed to complex double flowers.
